

MOSAICS

I use the direct method when making mosaics. This means that I find a suitable object, i.e. flower pot, table top, vase, stepping stone, etc. and glue the design onto the surface leaving spaces between for the grout.

After the glue has cured for at least 24 hours, the grout will be applied to the surface and cleaned and polished.

SUPPLY LIST:

Pieces of broken dishes; small tiles, glass globes, etc. Can be purchased at Michaels on Santa Rosa Avenue.

A small cement stepping stone or paver. I find that a flat object is best to start with. We will start with a simple design.

I will provide the glue and grout.
